<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Behave well at all times• Enjoy the game• Play by the rules• Accept the decisions of the supervisor/referee• Display good sportsmanship at all times• Show respect to your coach as well as your opponents• Never argue with a supervisor/referee or other official – without these people you can't play football.• Control your temper - verbal abuse of officials and abusing other players doesn't help you enjoy the game.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Treat all players as you would like to be treated – fairly• Never use bad language to team mates to opponents• Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your coach, team-mates and family if you do• Never criticise other players when they make a mistake• Never make fun of your opponents• Never be unsporting when you score goals• Shakes hands with your opponents at the end of the game
