17/ MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 8TH SEPTEMBER 2008

It was brought to the attention of the Secretary by Audra Ryder that an item was raised regarding the wearing of spectacles by girls when playing. The Secretary has since written to Catherine Lerner at the SCFA who had in turn passed it on to The FA. The Secretary has since received reply from Neale Barry (FA's Head of Senior Referees Department) which was circulated yesterday in the Weekly News Sheet. This will stay in the News Sheet until the end of the month.

With the above added the minutes were accepted and signed as correct by Alan Knight.

18/ MATTERS ARISING THERE FROM

4 The Secretary received the following reply from Michelle Lawrence: No, a player involved with the development group will be drafted in under those circumstances. If however a player demonstrates an improved capacity to be included, a seven-day approach could be made to include the player in Centre fixtures.

The development group is specifically for last season's (2007/2008) Under 10's (this season's Under 12's) who did not demonstrate the capacity at this time to be included in Centre fixtures. Rather than discard them, we are hoping to support their continued technical/physical development. Alan Knight will continue to monitor the situation closely.

Unlike other Centre's in Brighton's region, squad sizes were deliberately kept to a minimum. After Christmas, when Centre fixtures are permitted to go from 7 v 7 to 9 v 9 (Under12) and 9 v 9 to 11 v 11 (Under 14), Brighton will not move to the bigger game format.

Clubs do need to bare in mind that if a player approaches the Centre or is recommended, and they are at the required level then a seven day approach can be made to include that player in the programme regardless of whether the player is with the Development Group or not but in the spirit of Centre/Club relations, I would not expect to recruit players until the summer.

The Secretary did point out to Michelle that there was no need for a seven day approach but a mere courtesy letter.

11ee Due to further withdrawals from the Women's Section it had been necessary to amalgamate the two divisions.

- a. SCFA Ltd. – League Statement (Club Suspensions) – Hastings Hawks Ladies suspended for non-payment of Affiliation Fees. No players from this League have been listed.
- b. The FA – Respect packs received and distribute to Clubs with the help of Brian Shacklock, thanks to him.
- c. Patcham United Girls FC – Toilet facilities at Partridge Green Youth Girls FC, or lack of them. The Secretary has written to Club Secretary (Simon Brown - Partridge Green Youth Girls) asking if there is any way the situation can be improved.
Reply received back from Partridge Green Youth. The decision of the Committee is that Jolesfield Common is not a suitable venue for competition matches until toilet facilities are available - Paul Preston to contact Club advising them that a new venue is required for this coming Sunday's fixture against Ashington Angels Girls. **(ACTION: Paul Preston)**
- d. Respectzone.com – Information about purchasing goods. Details will be circulated to Clubs shortly but you can find their website link on both League Websites.
- e. SCFA Ltd. – Appeal by Worthing Minors Girls regarding The League Committee awarding points to opposition. The appeal was heard on Friday (10th October) and was dismissed. The Commission found that the League had acted within their rules. Not sure what the Club hoped to achieve with this appeal as the SCFA had already advised them that they would lose such an appeal. The Appeal Fee was retained by SCFA.
- f. The FA – Women's Pyramid of Football Regulations – to be signed by Chairman and Secretary and returned. The Secretary made criticism that there were new rules passed at the Women's Football Conference AGM in June and we have only just received them. A little late to include in the Handbook, however the League Website versions have been amended.
- g. The FA – Get into Football News – various details inc. Funding, Referees, Respect and Coaching etc.. Have pulled off Application Form for Funding of Leagues.

Have explained why this is required a previous meetings. It was reiterated that this was important especially with changes in personal afoot for Season 2009/2010.

It was agreed that the above should be on a League Policy Statement as the League was not informed of changes for this season by the SCFA until it was too late to circulate for Rule Amendment. Paul Preston to advice Clubs of changes with immediate effect and Russell Brooks to inform the Match Officials.

APPENDIX/FIXTURES SECRETARY REPORT - October 2008

The past month has again been very busy and alas my report is not as extensive as it could be. Again, we have been affected by late withdrawals and have revised games in more than one division. The biggest change has undoubtedly been the Womens Division where the withdrawal of Hastings Hawks left us with a severe imbalance - 10 teams in Division One and 4 teams in Division Two. Therefore, the only option open to me was to merge the divisions, which in turn meant that we could not fit the fixtures in even if we had pleasant weather for the rest of the season. Double-headers were therefore arranged so that the fixture list could be compiled in such a way so that any postponements can be rearranged without having to completely revise the fixture list.

At the time of writing, there have been over 50 unfulfilled fixtures. The vast majority of these have been because teams have not been able to get enough players to fulfil the fixture. This of course is worrying as it seems to be a consistent theme throughout all of the divisions. Do you think it might be advantageous to your girls to speak to another local club to see if merging is the way forward? It is a difficult subject but I am concerned that if we have the dropout rate of clubs that we are experiencing - is your club dropping out of the League the right thing to do when there are girls wanting to play football? We are told by the SCFA that there are lots of girls receiving training in the schools but do not have a club so if you are one of those teams that is struggling every week then why not give them a call to see if they can do anything for you.

Please remember if you are the away club and have not received match details by the stipulated time then please follow this up with the home club immediately.

Kick-off Times - Bob has put in the weekly news sheet a request for clubs to advise me of the kick-off times for your home matches each week. Some Clubs are not adhering to this. We are looking to have a complete record of when and where matches within the SCWGFL are taking place so please do let me know. I update Full-Time before the Sunday match day of the kick-off times. I will start chasing clubs up who have not been advising of such arrangements. All it costs is a cc to the email you send to opponents. If you can add the venue as well then this helps enormously as well.

Girls Clubs - Remember there are no free weeks this season apart from December 21 and 28 and as previously mentioned, you have to apply using the Closed Date Application Form and supporting evidence at least four weeks in advance of the match that you wish to avoid. Clubs have not been adhering to the four week period and therefore I cannot change the fixture. Remember these processes have been put in place because certain clubs abuse their privileges so please do not let them succeed, check with your players as to their availability at least one month in advance and if there is a problem because of an educational activity then please let me know.

Clubs have not been letting me know of postponements - simple things here. It delays rearranged dates going out to clubs. Save yourself a fine and drop me a line if you are the defaulting club for an unfulfilled fixture or the home club for a postponement.

Some Clubs have between themselves decided when not to play a game without consulting me first. This is not best practice, please give me a ring first.

Telephone messages - Anyone contacting me and wanting a call back, please leave a message regarding what it is you are calling about, your name and position within the Club and a contact number. I haven't taken GCSE Telepathy. Any message regarding any League matters which has not been left by the Club Secretary or Fixture Secretary (as indicated in the SCWGFL Handbook) will not be returned.

League Matters - Please do not ask me for rulings on League matters outside of fixtures. I will always refer you to the appropriate League Officer for their decision. If they give you a decision which you do not like, this does not mean that you can then ring another League Officer hoping for the answer you want to hear. I am also going to partially encroach onto Russell's patch here and mention appointed referees - the complete list of referees and contact details are on the Full-Time website, please use this.

If Russell has appointed a non-regular League referee to your game, please refer queries to Russell in the first instance.

I will be reviewing how the divisions are looking next month but always happy to receive your views about anything fixture related. Looking especially at the Womens Clubs playing double-headers in amongst the League programme and all teams who are in a countywide division. I have not received any feedback about the midweek games in September. Did you like them? I'm assuming no news is good news and everyone who played in them appreciated it.
