The Secretary said he had written to the Chairman of the Club asking that the Club distance themselves from Samantha's remarks. In his reply the Chairman on behalf of the Club apologized unreservedly for the regrettable email sent by his Club's former Secretary.

- a. **TREASURER** (Paul Baston)
- Bank Balance available to League: **£19,803.07** (*see: Appendix – Accounts*)
 - The Treasurer reported that the League is in a healthy position but will notice a sudden impact when the Designated Spectator Area Barriers have to be paid for.
 - Reported that Premier Leisure had paid for the advertising in the Handbook.
- b. **SECRETARY** (Bob Rashbrook)
- Just like to clear up confusion when we have a Worthing Town situation. In my capacity as a member of the SCFA Sanctions Committee it was agreed that a proposal from another League be accepted in that they could have two teams playing in the same division, providing they are call i.e. “A” and “B”. Calling themselves i.e. “United” and “City” would mean them having to affiliate to the SCFA as a separate Clubs.
 - Permission was given to order trophies for Season 2008/2009 (JEM Trophies) – the Secretary informed the meeting that he had no problems with this supplier.

 - Malcolm said he was concerned that having received Match Return details on several occasions from Withdean Youth 2000 Girls their team details did not match those that were on their opposition’s returns. The Clubs response to Malcolm when asking why there was a difference was that it was basically computer illiteracy on the Managers part. It was fully agreed by the meeting that the Club is dealt with under incorrect details (League Rule 11(Aii)) for each offence.
- e. **FIXTURE SECRETARY** (Paul Preston)
- Report circulated to meeting (*see: Appendix – Fixture Secretary*)
 - Unfulfilled Fixtures – report circulated to meeting (*see: Appendix – Unfulfilled Fixtures*)
 - Unfulfilled Fixture – Sunday 9th November 2008 ~ Newhaven Girls v Littlehampton Town Girls (Under 11). After a lengthy discussion where all the correspondence received was put before the Committee this decision was made:
1/ That Newhaven Girls Football Club be fined £10.00 in accordance with League Rule 10(D) – failing to notify opposition of full particulars of fixture and that Newhaven Girls Football be reminded of their responsibilities to the appropriate rule/League updates.
2/ That Littlehampton Town Devils Football Club are reminded of their responsibilities to the appropriate Rule (10(D)).
3/ That the match to be rescheduled by the League Fixture Secretary at his earliest convenience.
 - It was reported that AFC Burgess Hill Town Ladies had entered the Ryman’s League La Senza Women’s Cup. The Secretary had written to the Club asking whether they had sought permission from SCFA to enter this competition, he was awaiting a reply. It was agreed the Secretary write to the SCFA asking the same question. **(ACTION: Bob Rashbrook)**
 - League Challenge Cup Final dates and venues – The Secretary said he had arranged in conjunction with the Fixture Secretary the Cup Finals for the following:

- A decision on the Under 12/11 League Challenge Cup Finals has not been made but if any Club would like to hold these finals at their ground please contact Paul Preston. It is not necessary that both finals need to be played on the same day.

f. **REFEREES SECRETARY** (Russell Brooks)

- ii. The Secretary said he was concerned that our appointments are clashing with the South East Counties Women's Football League (SECWFL). Russell went on to explain that it is not just the SECWFL but all Leagues. The Central Appointments do not distribute Referees to individual Leagues but just send out a list of dates when a Referee is available to all Leagues.

Secretary had to send out suspension letters to three Clubs; having taken the time to send out the Monthly Newsletter, Weekly News Sheets and even League Newsflashes he said he wish Clubs would take the trouble to read them, it would save pointless letters and fines being issued in the long run. The Secretary said the lame excuses given do not wash with him and in all three Clubs written too it was basically communication within their own Clubs.

APPENDIX – Fixtures Secretary Report

Under 11

Three clubs look like matching each other all the way - Patcham United, Littlehampton Town Devils 'A' and Adur Athletic 'A' and with matches between these clubs in November then there might be a clearer picture of who may be champions-elect. Littlehampton Town 'B' have yet to win a point - let's hope they get a point or three soon.

Under 12 (West)

Patcham United are the Barack Obama of the SCWGFL - 14 points clear in this division so it looks to be their season. Runners-up spot could go to five of the remaining six teams. Worthing Town are now fulfilling matches in this division.

Under 12 (East)

Any of the first five clubs could win the division - Eastbourne Girls, Crawley Wasps, Rottingdean Village, Dynamo Girls, Pevensey and Westham Junior Girls. We will see what happens here before the two week break over the festive period.

Under 13

Eastbourne Girls and Marle Place Wanderers remain undefeated at the time of writing. Bognor Regis Town and Crawley Wasps could yet pose a threat to the front two. Predators Tigers have yet to win their first point but still have four matches to play against the two clubs immediately above them.

Under 14 (West)

Worthing Minors, Northfield and Patcham United look to be the front runners here. Storrington and Sullington Vipers look for their first League points. With the recent poor weather, Patcham play Northfield towards the end of the season maybe there will be something to play for in this game.

Under 14 (East)

There are five clubs that are in contention for the divisional title - Seahaven Harriers, Oakwood Youth, Marle Place Wanderers, Glenco Girls and Eastbourne Girls. Lewes are still looking for their first League point.

Under 15

Patcham United and Littlehampton Town Devils appear to be the strongest teams here but Shoreham Girls and Horsham Sparrows are waiting for any slipups from the top two. Henfield Girls are awaiting their first League point.

Under 16

Six clubs look to be going for the winners and runners-up position with Glenco still unbeaten. Newhaven and Eastbourne United Colts play each other on Sunday 16th November to see who will get their first League points of the season - will it be a draw?

Women

With the double-headers being scheduled in this division, this is wide open as there are points being dropped by all clubs. AFC Burgess Hill are playing in the Isthmian Women's Cup on Monday 17th November v Merstham at Leylands Park. Crawley Down have yet to register their first point in the League. Eight of our clubs are in the quarter-finals of the SCFA Womens Trophy on Sunday 16th November.

After my review, a few words about what will happen for the rest of the season. I will be telling all Womens clubs to expect midweek matches when the evenings start drawing out again. I am certain that with matches being called off earlier than in previous seasons that we will be left with no alternative. I have already arranged double-headers in some of the Girls divisions to prevent a fixture backlog in April and May. If we find that divisions are ahead of schedule then I can always take the double-header out and put one match in for a future week.

Another reminder about Closed Dates - if you have players away on a school trip for a match day then apply for a closed date with at least four weeks notice. I have not turned down an application yet as the correct evidence has been supplied. If your players are away on holiday with their parents then this does not count as the fixtures have been released since July (amended hundreds of times) so everyone knows what weeks are playing weeks in the SCWGFL this season.

Postponements - Bob has emailed enough times and I mention it more than enough as well, but do please let me know when your game is off for weather conditions. If you are the defaulting club when you cannot raise a team, then you have to let me know as well.

Rearrangements - I am the only person who determines whether a match is rearranged or awarded to the other team unless the situation determines that a decision is made by the League Management Committee. Clubs do not agree this between themselves and then let me know - doing this would probably mean that your game is declared void. All Sundays are match days apart from the two weeks in December - you have asked for fixtures for the whole of the season so why decide not to play a game. On one hand when we are told we are denying girls football by not rearranging matches, are the clubs denying girls football by not playing the game when you don't have a full team to choose from?

A word of warning that this will be my last season as Fixtures Secretary - not because I don't like doing this role but because the League will have been wound up as there is no-one to take over the position of Secretary from Bob Rashbrook in season 2009/10. If you are interested in taking the role over from Bob then let him know very soon. I want to do this role again next season.
